Control Layout



Drive: Adjusts the gain of the Bigger Bloom. At lower Drive settings, your guitar tone will be open and less saturated; you will hear inspiring tones from classic rock legends. At higher Drive settings, the pedal will push your notes into lush and full overdrive and take you into hard rock territory.

Tone: The tone control shapes the EQ frequencies of the pedal. As you move clockwise, you will hear brighter tones and more emphasis on mids and highs. At lower settings, the pedal will darken up and round off the high end.

Accent: Similar to a presence adjustment, the Accent will shape your tone in a slightly different manor than the Tone control. By adjusting the Accent control you will hear a more global shift in the EQ with more bite and rawness at higher accent levels

Volume: Adjusts the overall volume of the Bigger Bloom. You will want to use the Volume control and Drive controls as a "pair", allowing you to flavor the overall output and saturation and gain levels to get your desired tone.

Rock/Jazz Switch: The Rock/Jazz switch changes the framework of the pedals EQ. Jazz mode will be less aggressive with a slightly muted output and softer attack. Rock mode is a more aggressive and higher gain setting with a hotter output.

Jacks

Input: Right side of the pedal indicated by an "in" icon **Output:** Left side of the pedal indicated by an "out" icon

Power Requirements

Please install a 9V battery, or connect to an appropriate 9V DC "negative center" power supply with 10mA of power. Do not use more than 9V, or your warranty will be voided.



Servicing Warranty

Our pedals carry a non-transferable two-year warranty for any problem related to the function or operation of the pedal due to faulty parts and/or other internal problem. Please contact us with the original receipt if you have any issues.
